

CARAVAN PRE-TRIP TOWING CHECKLIST

MUST-DO'S BEFORE HITTING THE ROAD

CARAVANS

PRE-TRIP INTERIOR CHECK

- Secure all loose items and luggage within your Titanium Caravan. ☐
- Close and secure all internal doors and cupboards, including the refrigerator door. ☐
- Disconnect the TV, take it off the bracket and secure it. ☐
- Secure vents, hatches, skylights, and windows. Leave window shades open. ☐
- Turn off the water pump, inverter, gas and hot water system. ☐
- Turn off the 12v switch (main black switch near door). ☐
- Lock the door, and confirm it's secure. ☐

PRE-TRIP EXTERIOR CHECK

- Lock all external storage hatches and compartments. ☐
- Turn off your gas bottles and close the green valve. ☐
- Ensure your awning is locked and secured. ☐
- Retract the entrance step and stabiliser legs. ☐
- If applicable, check that your airbags are at the correct height as per manufacturer's specifications. ☐

CARAVAN HITCHING

- Ensure the caravan is correctly coupled to the tow vehicle and you have locked the pin on your Cruisemaster hitch. ☐
- Crisscross safety chains and securely connect to tow bar. ☐
- Connect the 12 pin cable, breakaway cable, Safety Dave cable and all necessary Anderson plugs to the tow vehicle. ☐
- Disengage the handbrake. ☐
- Raise and secure the jockey wheel. ☐

WHEELS

- Ensure all wheel nuts are correctly tightened (Use a torque wrench and tighten to 160nm). ☐
- Re-tighten wheel nuts at intervals (first 100kms, then every 250kms). ☐
- Check and maintain correct tyre pressures according to the tyre sidewall. ☐

LOADED MASS

The loaded mass of your caravan must not exceed:

- The maximum capacity of the ball weight. ☐
- The GVM specified by the towing vehicles manufacturer. ☐
- The GCM specified by the towing vehicles manufacturer. ☐
